1. Certified Dialysis Technologist: (8 to 10 months) Includes:

Classroom and Hands-on training on a Dialysis Machine
270 clock hours of Externship at Dialysis facility
Dialysis Program is accredited by BONENT (Board of Nephrology Examiners, Nursing & Technology)
Eligibility to the BONENT National Certification to become Certified Dialysis Technologist

2. Surgical Technologist: (12 to 14 months) Includes:

Classroom and Hands-on training in the College lab
250 clock hours of Externship Surgery Centers

3. Advance Pharmacy Technician: (8 to 10 months) Includes:

Classroom and Hands-on training which includes Pharmacy Software Training and simulated pharmacy tasks
200 clock hours of Externship at our affiliated pharmacies
Eligibility to the National Certification to become Certified Pharmacy Technician

4. Advance Medical Billing and Coding: (8 to 10 months) Includes:

Classroom and Hands-on training which includes Billing and Coding software and Billing and Coding case studies
Eligibility to the two National Certifications for:
1. Certified Medical Billing Specialist, and
2. Coding Certification

5. Diploma in Medical Assisting: (8 to 10 months) Includes:

Classroom and Hands-on training in Phlebotomy, EKG, and Medical Assisting
Eligibility for Phlebotomist, EKG, and Medical Assistant Certifications through NCCT
Eligibility for Patient Care certification through NCCT for those who have or will complete CNA
180 hours of Medical Centers based Externship at our Affiliated Sites
Eligibility for Phlebotomy & MA certifications from AMT after meeting additional requirements

6. Electroneurodiagnostic (END/EEG) Technologist: (8 to 10 months) Includes:

Classroom and hands-on training on END/EEG machines, Evoked Potential (EP) & Poly-Somno
Up to 270 hours of END/EEG Externship at our affiliated hospitals and clinical sites.
Certificate of Completion from our College

7. Radiology/X-Ray Tech: an 18 to 20 months diploma program

Includes: Classroom and Hands-on training in the College Lab
Externship at our affiliated hospitals or Radiology centers &/or Hospitals
East-West University offers eligibility to the License Examination



8. MRI Technologist: 18 to 20 months diploma program Includes:

Classroom and Hands-on training on a MRI Machine at an affiliated MRI Center
Externship at our affiliated hospitals or MRI centers
Eligibility to the ARMTRIT National Certification to become Certified MRI Technologist

9. Diagnostic Medical Sonography: 18 to 20 months; General (Abdominal/Small Parts)/ OB-GYN & Vascular Ultrasound Specialties; Includes:

Classroom and Hands-on training in Abdominal/ Small parts/ general ultrasound on Acuson, Toshiba and GE Machines/ 2D/3D Imaging
Also includes VASCULAR ultrasound and OB/GYN Specialties
Externship at our affiliated hospitals or diagnostic centers

10. Non-invasive Cardiovascular Sonographer: 18 to 20 months; Consists of two modules

First Module: Cardiology Tech - duration 4 months
Training in EKG, Holter monitoring and Stress Testing
Up to 120 hours of Hospital based Externship at our affiliated Hospitals.

Eligibility for Certified Cardiographic Certification through the CCI Registry

Second Module: Cardio-Vascular Sonography - duration 14 to 16 months

Hands-on training in CARDIAC ultrasound (also called ultrasound of the heart or ECHO)

Hands-on training in VASCULAR Ultrasound
Externship at our affiliated hospitals or diagnostic centers

Eligibility to the National Certification for Cardiac Ultrasound or Echo Technologist
